Flexible Choices Transportation Rules

Transportation Expenses in Flexible Choices  
April 18, 2008

Participants may use their Flexible Choices allowance to pay for transportation associated with their identified functional needs. These may include:

- The purchase of adapted vehicles
- Costs associated with adapting existing vehicles
- Costs of maintenance of adaptive equipment on vehicles
- Other costs associated with activities that clearly relate to their identified functional needs. This can include:
  - Trips to the grocery or other stores to acquire personal essentials.
  - Trips to therapies that are not covered by community Medicaid.

Types of transportation that may be reimbursed include:

- Bus or specialized bus transportation.
- Taxis.
- Expense payments to informal transportation providers (e.g., family and neighbors).

Participants may *not* use their Flexible Choices allowance to pay for:

- Purchase of non-adapted vehicles.
- Maintenance of any vehicle, except as noted above.
- Transportation that is associated with recreational activities.
- Transportation costs that are covered by Community Medicaid.
